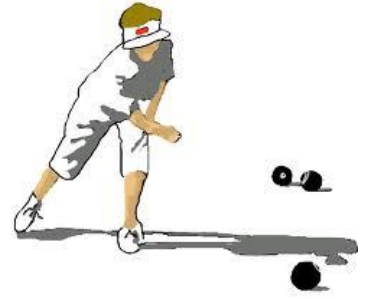




## Newsletter 2017
